Before me, Austin C. Brady, Consul of the United States of America in and for the consular district of Malaga, Spain, duly commissioned and qualified, personally came Librada Galvez Lopez, who, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

My true name is Librada Galvez Lopez; I am the wife of Manuel Lopez Ruiz, now a citizen of the United States of America, to whom I was married on April 29, 1914, at Alhama de Almeria, Spain; I was born at Alhama de Almeria, Spain, on January 4, 1893, and am of Spanish nationality; on June 12, 1930, I went to the office of the Civil Governor of the Province of Almeria in Almeria to obtain the signature of the Governor to my passport and the passport of my minor son, Juan Lopez Galvez, but I was told there that the Governor would not sign the passports because, as my husband is now a citizen of the United States of America, I and my minor children were no longer considered Spanish subjects; as a result of this I was unable to have the Spanish passports completed.

I will be accompanied to the United States by my four minor children, Juan, Ana, Cristobal, and Manuel Lopez Galvez, aged 15, 13, 9, and 2 years, respectively.

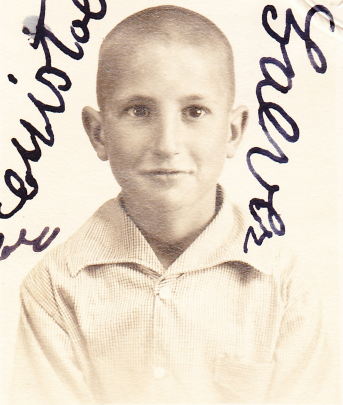
